E-minor -- NO capo

If you have large hands or are playing on a dulcimer with a shorter VSL, I think you will enjoy the fuller D-major chords you can reach without the capo. Compare the chords in this version with the Capo-1 version.



\* Sharon's original tune actually ends here, but I've repeated measures 11-14 for use as a coda or interlude, using different chords the second time. She has not indicated any chords, so I was free to make my own choices!
